In The Name of God Amen, The Third Day of Agust in The Year of Our Lord 1700 I George Sleeker of The State of So Carolina & County of Chaster Being Through The Mercy of God Tho Weak in Body & Calling to Mind The Mortality of my Body & That it is Appointed for all Living Once to Dye & After Dath to Come to Judgmt----Do make Constitue & Appoint This my Last Will & Testament Imprimis, I Leave my Body to the Earth.& my Soul to almighty God And as Concerning Such Worldly Esttate Which it hath Pleased God to Bestow on me I Leave Bequeth & Dispose of in The Following Manner & Form---Imprims I Leave & Bequeth all my Land to my Sone William Excepting my Wifes Lawfull Share & my Sone Dying in none age my Dr is to have the Land I Leave & Bequeth my horse Cratures Cowes Hogs & Sheep for The use of my Wife & Children Likewise all my Houshold furnitur of Whatsoever Kind Likewise all my Plantation Impliments Whatsoever I will That my Closs may be Disposd off for the use of my Sone & Likewise my Gunn-----I Constitue Ordain & Appoint Edwd White & my Wife Agns Executrix of This my Last Will & testament in Witness Whereof I Have Hereunto put my hand & Seal The Day & Year first above Written
