HUGH COOPER

IN THE NAME OF GOD ALMIGHTY I Hugh Cooper of the State of South Carolina & Chester County (Weaver) being in perfect health of body & in perfect mind & memory thank's be given unto god but calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say, Principally & first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty god that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be interred in a Decent & Christian Manner at the Discretion of my Executors, Nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of god. And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased god to bless me in this life I give, devise & dispose of the same in the following Manner & Form-----
First, I give ~~an~~ bequeath unto my beloved son Robert Cooper five shilling Sterling to be made & levied of my Estate----- Likewise I give & bequeath unto my beloved son John Cooper five shillings Sterling to be made & levied of my Estate----- Likewise I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Ferguson the whole of my lands & Tenaments with heir appurtenances VIZ three hundred Acres of land the same by her freely to be enjoyed forever, likewise I Give & bequeath unto her the whole of my personal Estate Except ten pounds Sterling which if after my just debts and funeral charges are paid & some notes of hand be recovered their be that sum remaining, I give & bequeath it unto my beloved Daughter Jane McCampbell to be paid unto her in cash-----

last will & Te tament, that is to say, Principally & first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty god that gave it & my body I recommend to the Earth to be interred in a Decent & Christain Manner at the Discretion of my Executors, Nothing doubting but at the General resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of god.

Likewise I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Ferguson the whole of my lands & Tenaments with heir appurtenances VIZ three Hundred Acres of land the same by her freely to be enjoyed forever, likewise I Give & bequeath unto her the whole of my personal Estate Except ten pounds Sterling which if after my just debts and funeral Charges are paid & some notes of hand be recovered their be that sum remaining, I give & bequeath it unto my beloved Daughter Jane McGaughy to be paid unto her in cash-----

and I do hereby constitute make & ordain Elizabeth Ferguson and Hugh Hitesides sole Executors of this my last will & Testament & I do hereby utterly disallow and disanul all & every other former Testaments Wills Legacies Bequests Executors by me in anywise before Named Willed & bequeathed Ratifying & confirming this & nother None other to be my last will & Testament IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this sixteenth day of January in the Year of our Lord One thousand
