In The Name of God Amen I James Brown of Chester County in the State of South Carolina being very Sick & weak in Body but of sound & perfect in minde & memory calling to minde the mortallity of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die, Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament (that is to say) Principally & First of all I give & recomend my Soul to the hands of God that gave it & my body to be Bury in a decent manner at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing dubting but I shall Recceive the same again at the General Resurrection by the mighty power of God ----And as touching such wordly Goods wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me in this life I give devise & dispose of the same in the following Manner Viz I Give & bequeath to Anne my Dearly beloved wife my bay Mare , commonly called her Mare & her Saddle & Bridle. Item, I Give & bequeath to my Two Sons Abraham Brown & Thomas Brown the ~~one~~ ~~one~~ Tract of Land on Thickety Creek containing about three Hundred acres to them & their Respective Heirs & Assigns forever I Likewise give unto my Said Son Abraham Brown one bay Mare commonly called his Mare together with his Saddle & Bridle To my Son Thomas Brown I give one Sorrel mare which is commonly called & known by the name of his Mare together with his Saddle & Bridle, And I Give to my loving wife aforesaid the Sole use & Benefit of my Plantation on which I now live with all my lands adjacent thereto During the Term that she shall live/ my widow & at her marriage or death I Give & Bequeath my Plantation and Lands last above mentioned to my Six children by my last marriage to be Equally Divided Between them to them & their respective Heirs & Assigns forever & all the remainder of my Personal Estate not already herein Bequeath I
