her Decease I will that he be Given to my youngest Daughter

Item I will & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Nancey the
plantation I Now Live on

Item I will & bequeath that my Said plantation be for the
use of my wife & Children During her widowhood or till my
Daughter Nancey is Married then to go as above

Item I will & bequeath that the Remainder of ^{my} Estate be
Diveded Equally Betwixt my wife & two Daughters Such as all
my Stock Goods & Chatles houshold furniture & plantation

tools & I will that my Lawfull Exeacuters with ^{the} / Indgment
of three other men Shall Divide the Same as the Law Diverts

Item I will that if any one of my Daughters Should Die
ormarried that her part be Given the Survivor

Item I appoint James harbison & James Dun Executor of this
my Last will & testament Signed Sealed & Declared by the
testate as his Last will & testament in presence

of us-----
