this my Last will and testament; that is to say principally
and first of all I Give and recommend my Soul into the hands
of almighty God that Gave it, and my Body I recommend to the
earth to be Buried in Decent Christian Burial at the Descretion
of my Executors notwithstanding but at the General Res-
urrection I Shall Receive the same again by the mighty power
of God and as touching such worldly Estate herewit. God hath
blessed me in this Life I Give Devise & Dispose of the same in
the following manner and form—First I Recommend my loving
wife agnes Gill my Son Samuel Gill, Elizabeth Gill
Robert Gill, Miranda Gill, and George Gill, my well beloved
sons and daughters to live together in the won ~~the~~ dwelling house
which I now live in and to jointly enjoy the plantation
