One part I give to my son Samuel Sealey another to my/grand son Jeremiah Sealey Terry and another to my grandsons Thomas & Sam. Sealey( sons of Peter Sealey) and the other part to my Three Grandchildren Viz Peter Sarah and Elizabeth Harden to be equally Divided Amongst them
