JOHN ROGERS

In the Name of God Amen the Tenth Day of January In the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine John
Rogers of Chester County and State of South Carolina Single man
Being sick and weakly in Body but of perfect mind and memory
Thanks be unto God for the same; and calling to mind the mor-
tality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men
Once to Die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament
that is to say Principally and first of all I give and Rec-
ommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it; and for my
Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian
like and decent manner at the Discretion of any of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive
the same again by the mighty power of God and touching such
worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Bless me in this
life I give Devise and Dispose of the same in the manner and
form following that is to say---In the first place I give and
Bequeath to Priscilla Frankling John and Thomas Beaker Frankling
the Bay mare about Five Years Old has Branded with the letters
J. S. about fourteen hands high and my riding Saddle I give and
leave to Thomas Baker Frankling also I give unto John Frankling
the Oats and Corn, the Corn by computation is thirty Bushels,
and the Oats by computation is Twenty five Bushels I likewise
constitute make and Ordain my only and sole Executor Thomas Baker
Frankling of this my last will and testament all and Singular
by him freely to be possessed and enjoyed and I do hereby utter-
ly Disallow Revoke and disannul all and every other Testaments
wills and Legacies Bequests and Executors by me in any wise be-
fore this time named Willed and Bequeathed Ratifying and Con-
firming This and no other to be my last Will and Testament In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day
and year above written
