of the said tract of Land I give and Bequeath it to my Beloved
Sons James & John an Equal part Secondly I have and Bequeath to
my Dearly Beloved Wife Mary the Black mare which I raifed my
felt and the other to my sons Samuel and Andrew thereby I give
to my Dearly Beloved Wife one cow and calf and allmy Houfehold
furniture to be kept on the place for the ufe of the family
and I do make and ordain my Dearly Beloved wife & my son James
my sole Executors of this my last will in witness whereof I
have herewith set my hand and seal this sixth Day of April
one thousand seven hundred & Eighty Seven
