 the personal Estate and to be couled fit to keep a trades-  
 man book off his own third and the Remaining third to my young  
 master and I Constitute appoint William Patten Jr. ~~sole exec~~  
execut<sup>r</sup> to this my last will and testament

and my wife Margarett Stewart sole Execut<sup>r</sup> of this my Last will  
 and testament this 29th of October 1780
