from the River out to the Back Line I Give to my Son Stephen

I give to my Daughter mary Crosby one negro named Rachel and
one Heater or Bed and Furnitur; I do Confititute and appoint my
Truffy and well Beloved wife Margaret Crosby and my Son Dennis
to be Executrs of this my Laft Will and teftament and hereby
revoking all other wills by me made do Confirat this to be my
Last Will and Teftament in fitness Whereof, I have hereunto Set
