resurrection I Shall Recieve the same again by the mighty pow-  
er of god and as touching such worldey estate where with it  
has pleased god to bless me in this life I give devise and  
disposse of the same in the following manner and form herst  
I give and bequath to William McDonald or his ~~sons~~ <sup>Heirs</sup> leaven in  
waterfound in the yere 1772 my brother and John my brother  
living in the Countee of Cork and parash of Connos I give all  
my personall estate to be devided betwised them and I do  
totally and Contrairly this and no other to be my last will  
and testment in witness wheror I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this 9th day of may one thousand seven hundred and  
ninety I do otherwise and impower Samuel B. Johnston and John  
Johnston to be my lawfull executer given ouer my hand and seal  
this twenty ninth of may 1790
