and I do likewise constitute make and Ordain Robert Walker of Rockey Creek & my beloved Mife Jean Walker to be my whale & Sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament And I do hereby utterly difallow Revoke & Disamul all & every ther Wills Legacies bequests and Executors by me in Anywise lefore this time named Willed & bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no Other to be my last Will & Testament In itnefs whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Day & Year first Above Writen
