In the name of God amen the sixth day of November 1787 I
 William Weer of the County of Chester and State of South
 Carolina planter being very sick & Weak in body but of
 perfect mind & memory the mentality of my body knowing that
 it is appointed Once for all men to die do make & Ordain
 this my last Will & Testament that is to say principally and
 first of all I give and Recommend my soul into the hands of
 God that gave it & my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be
 buried in A Decent Christian Buriel at the Deseration of
 my Executors Nothing Doubting but at the general resurection
 I shall Receive the same ag- in by the Mighty power of God and
 as touching such Worldly Estate Where with it hath pleased
 God to Blefs me in this life I give demise & depose of the
 same in the following manner & form first I do give to my
 well beloved son William Weer one bay Mear & two Cows which
 he is in pofsefsion of next I do give to my well beloved
 Daughter Elizabeth Weer her Bead & furniture with three head
 of Cows which is in my son Williams care with her saddel
 Next I do give to my well beloved son Samuel Weer three hun-
 dred acres of Land which is lying & being on the Waters of
 Tager River & the Dunn Horse and out of the above Lands he
 is to pay the sum of twenty pounds into the Hands of the
 Executor of this present Will. Next I do give to my well
 beloved wife ^Q Susana her Bead & furniture with one equal
 part of the following property which is to be equally div-
 ided between my said wife & my son James & my daughters
 Susana Agnas Margaret Janet & Ann which is to consist of
 the Plantation where on I now live with the live stock of
 Horses, Cowes & Hoges & Household Furnutue with my Plant-
 ation tools & what money be due me and the twenty pounds
 that is to be paid by my son Famuel and all the above is
 to be equally divided amoungest the persons above directed
 after they pay all my Debts Out of the whole sum and fur-
 ther I do Constitute & appoint my sons William & Samuel to
 be the Executors of this my last Will & Testament & John

till James arives till the Age of eighteen he is to Have it
at its value by paying the balance after his own Part is
