In the Name of god Amen I William Attaberry of the County of Chester being Sick yet in Sound Memory Do Make this My Last will and testament as followeth I give and bequeath to beloved wife Wright Attaberry the third of My Lands where the Chooses and the third of My Hoevebels also Item the Remainder part of the Land to be Equally Devived Between My three oldest Sons Thomas William and James but it is Not to be in full force of Law tell Ninty five and ^{those} three with the Rest is to join and work to gether to pay of the Dets but if Ither of them Neglects they Shall loose there part of the Land and his part Shall be Equally Devived Betwene the other tow Boys all things is to be Cept to gether tell the Day Ninty five and the Rest and Residue of my goods and Chatels and personal Estate after payment of my Dets Legacies and funeral Expences and unto My Doghter Mary Henderson I give one good Cow and Calf and the Rest of My Catel is to be Equally Devived amongst My three-ether three Daughters Mary Elender and Anney My three oldest Sons is to have a horse a peace and if there is aney Colts they Shall be given to My tow youngist Sons Nathan and Eliga and after this year Ninty five My two youngest Sons Nathan and Eliga Shall have one year and a half Close Schooling a piece fore their portion of Land and unto these two by Executors William Murrey and Nathan Attaberry of this My Last will and testament I give Demise and bequeath to them all and every My -essuage Lands tenements and hereditaments whatsoever an wheresoever which I also Charge with the payment of my said -ejecti In witness where of I have set My hand and seal William Attaberry
