I William Taylor of The Count, of Craven in the provence of South Carolina being in perfect health of Body and sound of mind and memory thanks be Given to God but Calling unto ~~the mortality of my body~~ and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die Do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to Say Principaly and first of all I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands of almighty God that give it, and my Body I Recomend to the Earth to be interred in a Decent and Christian manner at the Discretion of my Executors, Nothing Doubting but at the general Resurrection I ^{shall} Receive the same again by the almighty power of God, And as touching Such worldly Estate herewith it hath pleased God to Bless me in this Life I Give, Devise and Disposse the same in the following manner and form.)

(First)

I Give and Bequeath Unto Mary my Dearly Beloved wife all my whole Estate real and personal During her Life, and after Decease to be ^{Post^d} Divided in the following manner that is to say the whole Estate then remaining for to be Sold and the moneys arising there from to be Equally Divided in two parts and the one given to the poor and the other to the benefit of the Church-----

I Do hereby Nominate Constitute and appoint Cornelius Anderson and Samuel Dunlap to be Sole Executors of this my last

will and testament and I Do hereby Utterly Disallow Revoke
and Disanull all and Every other former wills and Bequeath-
ed Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my Last
will and testament---
