William Weir

In the Name of God Amen the Sixth day of November 1787 I  
William Weir of the County of Chester and State of South  
Carolina Planter Being Very Sick and Weak in Body bot of  
perfect Ind and Memory thanks be given Unto god Therefor  
Calling to mind and Memory the Mortality of my body and  
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to Die Do  
make and Ordain this my Last will and testament that is  
to say Principally and first of all I Give and Recommend  
my Soul into the hands of God that give it and my Body I  
Recommend to the Earth to be Buried in decent Christian  
Burial at the Discretion of my Executors. Nothing Doubt-  
ing but at the General Resurrection I Shall receive the  
same Again by the mighty power of God. And as touching  
such worldly Estate Whencewith it hath Pleased god to  
less me in this life I Give Demise and Dispose of the  
same in the following manner and form First I do Give to  
my well Beloved Son William Weir one Bay Horse and two Coves  
which he is in Posession of Next I do Give to my well Be-  
loved Daughter Elizabeth Weir hir Bedd & furnituer with  
tree Head of Coves which is in my Son Williams Care with  
hir Saddle Next I do Give my well beloved Son Samuel Weir  
the inter of three hundred acres of Land which is Lying & Being on Tager  
over & the Dunn horse and out of the above Lands he is to pay  
the sum of twenty pounds into the hands of the Executors of  
this present will Next I do Give to my well beloved wife  
Anna Weir hir Bedd and furnituer with an Equal part of  
the following property which is to be equally divided between

knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die and Ordain this by Last Will and testament that is to say Principally and first of all I Give and Recommend my Soul into the hands of God that give it and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried in Decent Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors. Nothing Doubtless but at the General Resurrection I Shall Receive the same Again by the mighty power of God. And as touching my earthly Estate Whencewith it hath pleased god to bless me in this life I Give Demise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and Form First I do Give to my well beloved Son William Weer one Bay horse and two Cowes which he is in Possession of Next I do Give to my well beloved Daughter Elizabeth Weer hir Bed & furnituer with three Head of Cowes which is in my Son Williams Care with hir Saddle Next I do Give my well beloved Son Samuel Weer three hundred acres of Land which is Lying & Being on Fager River & the Dunn horse and out of the above Lands he is to pay the sum of twenty pounds into the hands of the executors of this present will Next I do Give to my well beloved wife Susanna Weer hir Bed & furnituer with an equal part of the following property which is to be equally divided between my said wife and my Son James and my Daughters Susana Angnas Margaret Janet and Ann which is to consist of of the plantation where I now live with the Live Stock of horses Cowes Cales & Household furnituer with my Plantation tools and what Honeyeys maybe Due me & too ~~my~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~which is~~ to be payed by my Son Samuel and all the above is to be equally divided Amongest the persons above Directed after they pay all my Debts out of the wholl sum & further I Do Con-

constitute and appoint my Son William and Daniel to  
be the executors of this my Last Will and testament and  
John Mills jun their major & if they should think it Ex-  
pedient to Seal the Land above they may do it & if un Sold  
till James arrives till the Age of Eighteen he is to have it  
at its Value by paying the balance after his own part is  
subtracted from it-- And I do hereby Utterly Disallow and  
Revok all former testaments and wills by this- In witness  
hereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal the Day & Date  
above.
