Secondly- I give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Fanney C McIntosh, my Negro Fellow named Peter together with the whole of my other Personal Property Consisting of Cattle, Beds, and bed furniture and all other kind of Houshold & Kitchen furniture with every other kind of Property, that I may die Possess of to her and her heirs forever,
