which I have his receipt for. Also I give and bequeath to my son  
Amos Wright and his Heirs what he has already received and for  
which I have his receipt for Also I give to my son Joseph Wright.  
One Negro man named Jake and what he has already received to Him  
and his Heirs,  
Also I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Edwards and Her  
heirs five shillings sterling and what she has already received.  
Also I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Margaret Edwards  
Index to Darlington County Will Book 2 (1798-1812)  
One Negro man named Sid to her and her heirs. Also I give unto my  
Grand Daughter Mary Edwards One Bed two and her Heirs. Also I give  
and bequeath to my Grandson Benjamin W Hunter Son of my Daughter  
Margaret Hunter. One negro boy named Dave Two Him & his Heirs for-  
ever. Also I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Theany Edwards and  
her heirs five shillings sterling & what she has already received  
Also I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Margaret Hunter all the  
remainder of my Estate with what she has already received to Her &  
Her Heirs. and I do hereby make & Ordain my Worthy friend Hugh  
Lide James Coleman and Thomas Hunter Executors of this my last  
Will & Testament. whereunto I set my hand and seal the day & year ab-  
ove Written
