Pompey, Cesar- Andrew and two negro women Viz^t ~~Haze~~ and Jenny to her and her heirs forever (That is after the death of my Wife the first four mentioned Jenny. When ever she demands her) like wise all my lands Stock, Horfes Cattle sheep and Hogs together with my Houshold furniture after the death of my wife. Item I give and bequeath to my dear wife Mafsey Dewitt all my Real and Personal Estate at Longston County Will Book 2 (1798-1812) (except Jenny above mentioned who is to be ~~by said~~ www.southcarolinapioneers.net)

Mafsey M^cCall ----- Item I Give and (bequeath after my wifes death) To John M^cCall son of Francis M^cCall one negro boy named George and one Negro Girl named Lucy, --- Item I give and bequeath after my wifes death to Charles M^cCall son of John M^cCall one Negro boy named Briscoe

Item. I give and bequeath (after the death of my wife) to Frankey Mandaville one Negro Girl named Bian And

I do hereby Appoint my Wife Mafsey Dewitt Executrice and John M^cCall Son of Francis M^cCall and Rich Brockington Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do Revoke all former Wills declaring Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament
