And as touching my worldly estate, my will and desire is that all my just be paid; and that as much of the property of my said estate be sold as may be necessary to discharge the debts of my estate aforesaid; at the discretion of my executrix and executor.

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Dougherty- all the remainder of my estate with Book 2 (1798-1812) debts are paid. (during her natural life.) and after her decease my Will is that the said estate should be equally divided between my two Daughters Jean Hill and Hannah Norwood

Lastly I constitute ~~my beloved Son-in-law~~ my executrix and my beloved Son-in-law Chamble's Hill Executor of this my last Will & Testament: In Testimony whereof I have here unto set my hand & Seal this 7th day of April 1804
