I Elizabeth D. Cuttino of Darlington District and State of South Carolina, do make and publish this my last will and testament, in manner and form following that is to say, First, I give, devise and bequeath unto my sister Ann D. Murray the use of my dwelling House and Lot on Society-Hill in Darlington District aforesaid for and during the time that she shall remain unmarried; I also give and bequeath unto my said Sister Ann D. Murray my Tea Table furniture what little Stock I may have about my House except my riding Horse; I also give bequeath and devise unto my son Samuel D. Cuttino and his heirs, provided they live to become twenty one years of age or should marry all of the rest and residue of my property both real and personal, in possession, reversion and remainder; but if it should so happen that my said son Samuel should not live to become twenty one years of age or marry, I then give, devise and bequeath unto my friend Acron Marvin and his heirs, in trust, all of the property which I have herein before given to my son Samuel, to be ~~used by him~~ in educating such poor children as he shall consider to be proper and suitable objects of my bounty, those of my own relation to have a preference. And lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend Acron Marvin, the Sole Executor of this my last will and testament. and also the guardian of my son Samuel to take charge of his property and Education And do hereby revoke all former wills by me made . In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this second day of August in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred & thirteen.
