Memorandum of Articles which I propose giving my half brothers and Sisters Namely John Charles, ~~Harriett~~ & Betsy Mason Those matters which I am about to mention in this memorandum book is what I wish to be compl^d within -- case it should be pleased God to take me Out of this World without making a will and in that case without this Instrument of writing they would be roned Out of that which I intend they shall have I preceed to mention them vizt, 4 Beds, 3 Beds, Quilts, 4 Blankets, 5 sheets, 4 Boulsters 4 pillers, 6 Piller cafes, 11 Silver Table Spoons, 8 Tea spoons 1 mahagma Chest of Drawers, 1 large Flat Top Trunk, one Ditto Round Top D, 1 Ditto Ditto, 1 Small Trunk, 7 Cups & Saucers, 2 large Bowls, 3 Small ditto, 1 large Tea Pott, 1 Small ditto, 3 Wine Glaeses, ^{Index to Darlington County Will Book 2 (1798-1812)} 2 Small ditto, 11 Earthen Plates, 2 mugs, 1 Pepper Box, 2 Cream Pots, 1 Sugar Dish 2 Salt sellars, 2 Mustards Pots, 2 large Dishes, 2 Small Ditto --- 1 Negro fellow named Sam & Ditto Ditto named Dick, 1 Ditto D named Farten. Also that

my ~~estate~~ or assigns age the sum of Three hundred Pounds sterling in equal dividision between the four as also two Divide the above named Negroes and to other Articles Equal share & share alike I hereby declare This to be my Will as above Written and that I have thehereby delivered it that they may not be rong" out of it, in case I should die. Interstate, In witnefsth whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 11 March 1794
