I give my soul to God from whom I recieved it, trusting thro. the blefsed merits of my Saviour to recieve it again in glory at the Refurrection, my body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors: and as for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bestow on ~~me~~ I give & bequeath in manner & form following first I give and bequeath to my well beloved Son Daniel Beasle the Plantation and Land whereon I now live after his Mother's decease together with One Horse.

Second I lend to my well beloved wife Margaret Beasley the plantation and land whereon I now live during her life time and then

Third. I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife ~~Margaret~~ Beasley One Mare together with all my other stock and Household property it hath pleased God to bestow upon me.

Lastly I Ordain appoint and Constitute my well beloved Son Reuben Beasle and Stephen Thompson Executors of this my last Will and Testament,
