queath unto my wife Elizabeth during her life time (provided  
she does marry) the whole of my Estate except what is hereafter  
bequeathed but in case of her marrying the property except as  
first bequeathed to her to be disposed of to the best advantage  
for the use & benefit of my Children by her, at the Discretion  
of my Executors. Again I will and bequeath to my Son Satty Hafe  
a grey horse <sup>Index to Darlington County Will Book 2 (1798-1812)</sup> <sup>www.southcarolinapioneers.net</sup> ~~colt called Satty~~ to be at his disposal when  
he (Satty) shall arrive at the age of twelve years hereby nomi-  
nate and appoint my trusty Friends Alexander McArtha and Daniel  
Dubof with Abram Neson Executors to this will and Testament
