 thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety three Do Make this My Last  
 Will and testament in the Manner following that is to say first  
 I Recommend My Soul to almighty God Secondly My Body to be  
 Decently Buried and all my Just Debts to paid then I Give and  
 Bequeath unto My Beloved Wife five Negroes to Wit old Moses  
 Potodowe Ned Barsh & Cloe together With the Home Lands and  
 Plantation and the River Plantation With all My Stock of Cattle  
 Horses Sheep and Hogs and all My Household furniture only Such  
 Part of Stock and Household furniture as Shall Hereafter Mentioned  
 for and During Her Life and after Her Decease the Lands to Be  
 Equally Divided Between My three Sons John M'Call James M'Call  
 & Hawkins M'Call and in Case Ither of them Should Die Before  
 Such Division to the Surviving Ones and after Her Death the  
 above Mentioned five Negroes With their Issue and Increase to-  
 gether With all the Stock Household furniture and Other personal
