First I give & bequeath to my Grand-Son James Michal Sanders Twelve Negroes to wit Ned, Amos, Anthony, George, Abraham, Dennis, Jane, Sappho, Nancy, Esther, Doll & Beck, Also Six Heifers marked with a Slit in one ear and an Over-slope in the Other, to be left in the Care of his Father Jorden Sanders until Said James Michal Sanders be of Age

Secendly I Give & bequeath to my Grand-Son Nathaniel McCall Six Negroes to wit Jack, Ben, Adam, Rachel, Lydia & Lucy, Also Six Heifers Marked With a Crop & half moon in one ear & a Crop & under-Slope in the Other, and one young mare (to be Chosen by his Father George McCall) to be left in the Care of his Father George McCall until Said Nathaniel McCall be of Age

Thirdly I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Hannah Murfee Twenty-five Cents

Fourth & Lastly my Will is that the remainder of my estate Shall be sold Publicly in Order to pay my debts, and the Ballance th reof to be equally divided between my two Sons Moses Sanders & Jorden Sanders & my Daughter Elizabeth McCall Moses Sanders my Son & George McCall my Son in Law I have Chosen to be executors of this my Last Will & Testament Confiding in their Honour & fidelity to execute the Same According to the true Intent & meaning Thereof--
