Item It is my will and pleasure that after my Just Debts are discharged that the remaining part of my property and crop be equally divided between my three Children Barrell, Levy and Susannah, but with this exception that is to say my old negro man named Ben shall be supported out of this remain/ part of my Estate

Item Finally I do here by ordain & appoint Thomas Frank, Edward Rogers, Stephen Williams my Executors to this my last will and Testament revoking all other wills and Testaments heretofore made

In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 2nd day of December in the nam of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & five
