www.southcarolinapioneers.net the half of the land Alexander Thomas to have the Other half -- One Bay horse to Philip Thomas. then all the Perishable property to be equally divided between my Sons and Daughters and I do hereby utterly disallow Revoke and disannul all and every Other former Testaments wills legases--bequests and Executors by me in any wise before named willed and bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and Know Other to be my last will and testament in Witnefs whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this first day of June. in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and One Signed Sealed. published pronounced . and declared. by the Said Solomon Thomas as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us. Who in his presence and in the presents of each Other have hereunto Subscribed
