Item, I give to my well beloved Wife Sally Hixon all my land & Plantation also Three negroes two Women Selak & Sarah one named Philip an all my Stock of Horses, Cattle & hogs household & Kitchen furniture to fully in the power of the said Sally Hixon Item I give to my Daughter Hefse Prothro one negro girl named Sydia, Item I give to my son Eli Hixon one negro Boy named Daniel, Item, I give to my Son Levi Hixon one Negro boy named Amos, Item I give to my son John Hixon one Negro boy named Demsey- Item, I give to my son James Hixon one Negro girl Abille. Item I give to my daughter Sally Hixon one negro Girl named Rose Lastly. I do Constitute & appoint my well beloved Wife Sally Hixon William Prothro Jacob Morris sew executors to see this my last Will and Testament performed and complied with executed & Confirmed this tenth day of February one thousand eight hundred and Ten & in the thirty fifth year of American Independence Test,
