WILL OF THOMAS STANDLEY PAGE THREE

Whereas I Thomas Standley of South Carolina Darlington District
have made and duly executed my last will & testament in writing
bearing date this 26th October 1813 and thereby given all the
residuary part of my real & Personal estate to all my surviving
Children at the decease of my wife except my son James Standley
and my daughter Tilpha Sexton Share & Share alike, but I do re-
voke and make void the same, so as to give my Executrix and
Executor a discretionary Power to Give my said Children & feath-
er bed & furniture each who have not been provided for in the
proceeding will with beds so as to make their legacies as nearly
equal as possible, and I do ordain & and declare this present
writing to be a codicil to my said will and that the same shall
be annexed to my said will and do confirm my said will in every particular thereof that is not alter-
ed hereby or revoked In witness hereof I have to this codicil
set my hand and seal this 26th day October in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred thirteen
