except four beds & furniture by her freely to be possessed and
enjoyed and disposed of as she may think most proper I further
give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Five other negroes with
their increase, Viz, Judy Isaac, Sampson Susanna and Robert
son of Susanna also Plantation or tract of land where I now live
with the Houses by her to be Possessed and enjoyed while it
may Please god to ~~dispose of~~ ^{at her decease} it is my will
that the above named negroes Judy Isaac Sampson Susanna &
Robert with their increase be equally divided among all my
children that are alive at the death of my wife (The land I
shall dispose of as herein after mentioned) Also I give and
bequeath my son John I Muldrow the following negroes Viz
Isaac son of Tiner Sarah Peter Nead Amy Dick, ben, & Robert son
of Amy with their increase together with what other Property
he has now or before received by him to be freely Possessed
enjoyed and disposed of as he may think Proper Also I give and
bequeath unto my daughter Ann Cannon and son inlaw Hugh E Cannon
the following negroes Viz, Toney Big Lydia Little Lydia Chavous
Mindy, Abner & Robert Son of Phebe with their increase together
with what Property they have now or before received by them to
be freely Possessed enjoyed and disposed of as they may think
most proper Also I Give and bequeath to my two youngest children
Elies Diedorus and Elizabeth Lucretia the following negroes
