Benjamin Allen inersected by other surveys which were older, shows 38 acres and 58 acres, surveyed 11 April 1794 by Charles Banks D S, [shows Sarah Bakers land now held by James McQueen, McQueens mill, Campbellton road, Leroy Hammond, Eliz Miller, George Sommers land]

p.109-115 Charles Goodwin Esqr to LeRoy Hammond & George Whitefield exrs of will of Leroy Hammond decd, L&R and mortgage, 12 April 1794/13 April 1794, 5 shillings lawful sterling money, 3 tracts, one of 450 acres original grant to Elizabeth Miller [land described as above]. Wit Whitf Wilson, Jona Moore. /s/ Charles Goodwin. Proven 16 June 1796 by Jonathan Moore; Jno Trotter. Rec 27 June 1796.

p.115-118 Samuel Saxon late Sheriff of Ninety Six district to LeRoy Hammond of New Richmond in sd District, planter, late of Snow Hill in sd district. 4 January 1796. Plantation of LeRoy Hammond, deceased, 800 acres on Savannah R bounded E on Elizabeth Millers tract now belonging to Charles Goodwin, SW on Savannah R, NW on land granted to William Drake called now Richmond now belonging to sd LeRoy Hammond, and on other side partly on land granted to Benjamin Allen and John Bynan which tract is known as Thompsons hill and was granted to George Summers; suit of Eyre, Athemeon & Walter of City of London, merchants, who obtained judgment agt Leroy Hammond for sd sum, costs and charges by them paid in obtaining sd judgment; writ of John Rutledge dated at Cambridge 18 April 1792 to levy on estate of LeRoy Hammond decd to recover agt sd sums at public auction; sold to highest bidder LeRoy Hammond for £100 sterling. Wit Whitf Wilson, Jonan Moore. /s/ S Saxon, Shff 96 Dist. Proved 16 June 1796 by Jonathan Moore; Jno Trotter. Rec 27 June 1796.

p.119-122 Samuel W Goode of Georgia to Edmund Pursell[Pursley], L&R, 27 December 1785/18(sic) Decr 1795, £125 sterling, 150 acres on Horns Cr water of Stephens Cr willed to Samuel Goode by his father bounded by Andrew Burney, Macker-ness Goode, Saml Gardner, John Swillivan. Wit George Farrar, John C Garrett. /s/ Saml W Goode. Proved 8 June 1796 by Geo Farrar; Aquila Miles JP. Rec 28 June 1796.

p.123 Rice Swearengen to Jacob Wise, Bill of Sale, 19 March 1796, £40 sterling, a Negro girl Betty about age nine. Wit Absalom Napper, Benja Hatcher. /s/ Rice Swear-engen. Proved 1 June 1796 by Absalom Napper; Joseph Hightower JP. Rec 29 June 1796.

p.124-127 James Hargrove and wife Mary to Edward Mitchell. L&R, 30 October 1795/14 Octr 1795, £10 sterling, 83.5 acres bound by Jeters Lang, Welches, Doolittle, Matthews. Wit Hinchey Mitchell, Wm Hargrove. /s/ Jas Hargrove, Mary (x) Hargrove. Proved 2 July 1796 by Hinchey Mitchell; Richard Tutt. Rec 2 July 1796

p.127-129 John Still and wife Jeane Still to Benjamin Eddins late of Abbeville County SC, £200, 555 acres, resurvey by William Coursey, part of 500 acres granted to Richard Buckelew decd & descended by heirship to George Buckelew and conveyed by same to Jas Buckelew and from James Buckelew to John Still and part of 1500 acres granted to Hugh Rose lying on Little Steavens Creek. Wit James Eddins, James Blocker. John (I) Still, Jean (I) Still. Proven 1 July 1796 by James Eddins; John Blocker J P. Rec 2nd July 1796.

p.129-132 Daniel Stevens of City of Charleston to James Coursey of 96

District, L&R. 8 March 1796/9 March 1796, £60 current money of SC, 300 acres on Beaver Dam branch of Turkey Creek bounded by Hezekiah Williams, Robert Melville, William Goode. Wit James Prichard, Caul Collins. /s/ Danl Stevens. Proven 6 April 1796 by Caul Collins; John Blocker J P. Rec 4 July 1796.

p.132-135 Shiles Marsh and wife Mary to Ezekiel McClendon. L&R. 9 August 1795/10 Aug 1795, £50 sterling, 205 acres being the upper and east part where sd Shiles now lives, part of 410 acres granted unto Samuel Marsh decd by Gov Wm Moultrie in 1786, bound by Wm Marsh, Wm Frazure. Wit Ezekiel Robuck, William Marsh. /s/ Shiles Marsh. Proven 14 March 1796 by Ezekiel Robuck; Van Swearengen J P. Rec 4 July 1796.

p.136-139 Valentine Brazeel to James Herring. L&R. 19 August 1794/20 Aug 1794, 10 shillings sterling of SC, 126 acres on branches of Edisto River south of Saluda below Anchent boundary line near the Jester Ponds, beginning on land of Thomas Adams, incl improvement that Breton Brazeel now lives on, adj Benjamin McKinney, being part of 226 acres granted to Valentine Brazeel by Gov Charles Pinckney 4 April 1791. Wit Edward Couch, Elisha Baronton, Bibby Bush. /s/ Valentine (V) Brazeel. Proven 4 July 1796 by Bibby Bush; John Blocker J P. Rec 4 July 1796.

p.139-141 Bartlett Bledsoe to William Humphreys. Release. 20 June 1795, £20 sterling 200 acres on Red Bank Cr of Little Saluda R, original grant to Larkin Brown 1786 by Gov Wm Moultrie, and conveyed from Larkin Brown to Bartlett Bledsoe. Wit Henry King, Dency Wever. /s/ Bartlett Bledsoe. Proven 5 March 1796 by Henry King; Wm Daniel J P. Rec 4th July 1796.

p.141-143 Thomas Reed Senr to John Blalock of Newberry County SC. Deed 8 January 1795, £65 sterling, 100 akers part of 300 akers granted to Ann Dean by Gov Wm Bull on 8 July 1774 on Persimmon Cr of Little Saluda, conveyed by George Dean unto Saml More[Mare?] then from Saml Mare unto Thomas Reed Senr. Wit Jas Rutherford, Sannuel (x) Crow, Jno Blalock Junr. /s/ Thomas Reed. Proven 4 July 1796 by Saml Crow; Richard Tutt. Rec. 4th July 1796.

p.143-145 David Bell of Charleston SC to Charles Yancey of Amherst County, Province of Virginia. Deed. 26 December 1772, grant made 24 December 1772 by Gov Charles Granville Montague grant 200 acres in Granville County both sides Stevens Creek, sd David Bell for 10 shillings lawfull money of SC sold to Chas Yancey for one year 200 acres. Wit John Clark, John Mason, William Fitzpatrick. /s/ David Bell. 27 Dec 1772 recd £22.10 current money of SC. /s/ David Bell. Proven 4 August 1775 by John Clark; Arthur Jenkins J P. Rec 4th July 1796.

p.145-149 John Swearengen to John Wimberley. L&R. 13 November 1792/12 Nov 1792, £10 sterling, part of 530 acres granted 7 August 1786 to John Swearengen on Shaws Creek, adj Peter Hilliard, and now 450 acres where John Swearengen now lives conveyed by sd John Swearengen to sd John Wimberly. Wit Henry Swearengen, Joseph Jones. /s/ Jno Swearengen. Proven 3 Dec 1795 by Joseph Jones; Van Swearengen. Rec. 4th July 1796.

p.149-150 John Lucas Senr to John Lucas Junr. Deed. 119 acres adj Laurence Rambo, Capt John Ryan, John Lucas Sr, & surveyed by Bennett Crafton DS, part of
