IN THE NAME OF GOD, I Alexander M^CDowell do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in Manner and Form following

- That is to say I give & bequeath to my dear Wife Jane five Acres of Land fenced in and the House wherein I now live and also the use of my Negroe wench Hannah during her Natural life, and also the use of two of the best of my milch Cows at her Choise during her life. I give devise & bequeath to my Sons Alexander Smith now living with me all my real and personal Estate that I shall die pofeses, to be equally divided between them when they attain the age of twenty one; and at the decease of my Said Wife

I also give to my said two Sons Alexander and Smith the Land Negroe Wench and Stock of Cows their Increase to be like Manner equally divided between them I give to my

Sons Hugh Andrew & James and also to my daughter Jane

Annah the sum of one dollar each to be paid them within Six mont s after my decease if the same shall be demanded

- and I do hereby nominate Constitute & appoint my Wife

Jane, James M^Cdowell and Alexander M. Kane my Executors

hereby revoking all former wills by me made In Witnefs ---

whereof I have hereto set my hand and Seal this Second day of July in the year of our Lord 1793.
