natral life or widow hood and at he death to go to my  
Son John Henson

3<sup>rd</sup> I Do Constitute and appoint Robert Henson Benjamin  
Henson Executors to this my last will and testament In  
witnefs where of I have set my hand and seal this

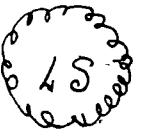
