one Guinea. 3rd I Give to my Grandfon Charles Harbison,
Six pounds, if he Comes into this Country; if not the
same to be Divided betwen My Brother Adam Aiken, & Daughter
Sarah. 4th I Give to My Brother Adam Aiken Four Guineas
to be Paid in property. 5th I Give to My Daughter Sarah
wife of Hugh McKelorg Two thirds of My property remaining
after the above mentioned legacies are paid off. (Viz)
the Legacies left My Brother, Daughter Jennet, & Grandfon
Charles & the partecular articles mentioned to my Wife.
And I Do hereby authorize, constitute and appoint my
loving Friends Richard Gladney, & Samuel Loughridge of
Fairfield County & Adam Eggar of Rocky-Creek Executors of
