I David Evans of Fairfield County, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament-- First I give and bequeath to my wife Mary Evans all my Estate both real and personal, during her Life to be and remain in her possession-- and after her Decease as Follows -- To my Son Joseph Evans I give a Negroe Boy named Jack, to him and his heirs forever-- ITEM, to my Son David Read Evans I give my house and Lott in Winnsborough, and a Negroe fellow named Binder, also, the Furniture of the common Parlour, to him and his heirs forever, the remainder of my Estate not before mentioned, to be at the absolute Disposal and Will of my said Wife forever, and I do hereby appoint my said wife Mary Evans as sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament, IN WITNES, ^{Fairfield County Will Book 2, 1792-1795} ~~whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal~~ ^{www.southcarolinapioneers.net} this eleventh Day of Duember in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six--
