Memory blefs'd be God, do this thirty First day of December in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred and Ninety five, make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and Form Following, First and principally I Commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my Body to be interred in a decent and Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors, And as for any Worldly Estate that God has been pleased to intrust me with I give and Bequeath it in the following manner; First I give and Bequeath to my Niece Sarah Milling one Negro Girl named Lucy, half a Dozen of silver Table Spoons, half a Dozen of of Silver Tea Spoons, 1 Silver soup Ladle, one silver Scissors Chain, one white Counterpane, half a dozen of Damask Napkins, one Table Cloth, and all the China in my possession. 2^d I Give and Bequeath to my Neice Mary Quarrel one Feather Bed one patch quilt and one Trunk. 3^d I Give to my Sister Sufanna Quarrel the Full amount of a Note due by Hugh Milling Esq^r for a Negro Girl for the Benefit of Her the said Sufanna Quarrel and her Heirs but not to be sold or made over for the benefit of any other person or persons whatsoever, 4.th Give my Dendue money to be divided equally between my two sisters Jane Milling and Sufanna Quarrel, after there is First taken out of the same as much money as will purchase a suit of Clothes for David Milling my Nephew. 5th. I give to M^{rs} Margt. McCreight my Hat; and all my other body Clothes to be divided between my Sister Jane Milling and her two Daughters. Sarah and Mary- Ann Milling, 6th I give to Esther Dunlap of Kershaw County one Mare Colt 7th I Give to my sister Lettece Hutchison ten shillings 8.th I Give to my sister Martha Miller ten shillings ster^l. And I do hereby authorize and appoint M^r: Samuel W. Yongue Sole

Executor of this my will in trust for the intent and

poses in this my Will Contained, and to take care and see the same performed according to my true intent and meaning. In Witness whereof I the said Esther Cook have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and Seal the day and year above written.
