Two Cows and Calves Iwo Sows and pigs, I leave to my Son Ambrose the remaining part of my Land to the Eastward of Little river it being the other part of the Track that I left to my wife, the remaining part of all my property I desire to be - divided among my Children, William, John, Francis, Sarah Elizabeth, Mary, Abigail, and Conestance reserving out of, the same Fairfield County Will Book 2, 1792-1795 a Childs www.southeardinapioneers.her widowhood, when the same to be divided among my Surviving Heirs, and I do further constitute Richard Winn and John Winn to be my Lawful Excutors to carry my said will into Effect, in every part thereof and if any dispute arise touching or concerning the same my Executors is to settle such matters. or disputes as they in their Judgment shall think best.
