~~as my last Will and Testament, First my Body be decently~~
 buried, then my debts to be paid, I Give to my Wife Mary
 Kirkland that part of Land whereon I now live to the
 eastward of Little river, this said river to be the Line,
 during her Lifetime then the said Land to be Sold or divided
 at the discretion of my two Executors among my Sons William
 Kirkland John Kirkland and Francis Kirkland, furthermore
 my wife is to have our Feather bed, Two Cows and Calves
 Two Sows and pigs, I leave to my Son Ambrose the remaining
 part of my Land to the Eastward of Little river it being
 the other part of the Track that I left to my wife, the
 remaining part of all my property I desire to be - divided
 among my Children, William, John, Francis, Sarah Elizabeth,
 Mary, Abigail, and Conestance reserving out of, the same
 a Childs ^{Fairfield County Will Book 2, 1792-1795} ~~part for my wife during her widowhood,~~ when the
 same to be divided among my Surviving Heirs, and I do
 further constitute Richard Winn and John Winn to be my
 Lawful Executors to carry my said will into Effect, in
 every part thereof and if any dispute arise touching or
 concerning the same my Executors is to settle such matters
 or disputes as they in their Judgment shall think best,
