one negrow named Jacob and one hundred Dellars Also I do give and bequeath to my daughter Elisabeth my plantation lying on the south id of broad river containing one hundred Dellars Also I de Dacres and one hundred Dellars Also I give and bequeath to my two grand children tarah and

Hary Bell two and rod Dodlors each And farth 1f my daughter

Mary should depart this lif without A.lawfull hair I do give and bequeath the plantatic and all bequeathe to her to my two grand daughters Sarah and Mary Bell far her if they should both dy without lawfull ishew - their peart shall be eaguely divided among my daughters of surviveing if not to their hairs Also the remainder of the Btook is to be sould and eacuely divided among my three daughters Also my negro Bob is to remain on the plantation as long as Hery lives in a state of Salebacy and then to be sould and esquelly divided among my the doughters. Also I do give to William Feemster twenty two Dollars I do appoint and constitute camuel Formator and Adam Cooper and Janual Jonson Executers to act and Le the above will Exacuter inn witness where? before the undernamed witnesses I have hereunto set my hand and soul this thirtieth lay of eptember in the year of our Lord one thousend eight hundred and two
