into the hands of Almighty God that gave it. And my body
I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian
burial at the discretion of my Executors, My Eldest Son
Solomon Martin and My Nephew Joshua Martin whom I Constitute
make and ordain the sole Executors of this my last will
and testament nothing doubting but at the general resurrec-
tion I shall receive the same again by the Mighty power of
God in as touching such worldly estate. Wherewith it has
pleased God to bless me with in this life. I give demise
and dispose of the same in the following manner and form.
First I gave to my son Solomon Martin one white
bred Cow and Calf named piny which is to be his share of
my worldly estate. also I gave to my beloved Son Owen Mar-
tin one saddle and bridle & one Cow that is with calf named
lilly. which is his part of my worldly ^{ld} estate. also I gave
to my beloved Son Samuel Martin one bay horse named childers
and one saddle and bridle. one Cow and Calf which is his part
of my worldly estate. also I gave to my beloved Daughter
Mary Martin one Sorrel Mare Saddle & bridle ^d, Mare named
Bonny one Cow & Calf one feather bed three blankets belong-
to ^d bed one pot & oven heel & two pair of chairs one dish
and two basons IX spoons which is her part of my worldly ^d es-
tate. also I gave to my beloved Son George Martin one stud
horse named Duke one saddle & bridle one Cow & Calf which
is his part of my worldly estate ^{of my stock} X also I gave to My beloved
son David Martin one brindle hiffer which is his part of
my stock

Also I gave ^{to} my beloved Son Hiram Martin one Sorrel Colt
named ball & one cow & calf Which is his part of my Stook

My Land tenements plantation tools black Smith tools
and the balance of my house hold furniture I leave to the
~~discretion~~ of my three Young est Sons named George David &
Hiram which I leave it to the dicrtion of my Executors to
divide Said property Equely between my Three Said Young est
Sons. Said property by them freely to be pofsefsed and en-
joy and I doo here by uttuly disallow Revoke & disanull all
and every other former testements wills. legacis Bequests
and Executors by me in any Ways before named willed and and
bequathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no ther to be
my last will and testement in Witnefs Whereof I have heare
Unto Set my hand ~~Fairfield County Will Book 2nd 1792~~ 1795 February in
the Yeare of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred & Ninety *nine*
& in the twenty Third Yeare of the independance of America
