I George Peay of the State of South Carolina in the County of Fairfield being very sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God, calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, That is to say principally and First of all I Give and recommend my Soul into the hand of Almighty God, that gave it and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors And as touching such worldly Estate/ as it hath pleased to blefs me with in this Life I Give devise and dispise of the same in the following manner and form. First I will that all my just debts be paid and discharged out of my Estate; I Give and demise to Elizabeth Peay, my dearly beloved wife all my plantation or Tract of Land containing two Hundred acres lying and being on the North Side of the Waterree River in Lancaster County to her and her Heirs forever, I also Give and bequeath to my said wife all my personal Estate, which I pefsefs or in whose hands or Custody or posefssefsion soever any part of the same is, or may be hereafter found and I do Constitute and appoint make and ordain my said wife sole Executrix of this my Last will and Testament IN WITNEFS whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the Twenty Second day of November in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety one
