gret Montgomery and her Heirs Lastly I do make and ordain
and Appoint my Trusty Friends Hugh Montgomery and Charles
Montgomery my Lawfull Executors of this ~~Will~~ Will and
Testament Dated this Sixth of July In the Year of our Lord
One Thousand Seven Hundred & Ninety;
