Do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament and as to my Worldly Goods that it has pleased God to bless me with I will and dispose in manner and form following that is to say first all my will and depose is that my justs debts should be paid without trouble or suits at Law all my desire is that my two hundred and fifty acres of land whereon I now live to be divided in two parts and one part to be sold at Public or private sale at the discression of my Executor in order to pay my debts and if it is not enough it not my desire is that he should sell as much of my moveable property as would settle my matters; Such as he thinks my family can best spare: The other half of my land I lend to my Wife Elizabeth Robertson her choice during her life and after her deceas to be equally divided among my five children William Robertson Hannah Elizabeth Mary and James ----I also lend her the remainder of my property after my debts is paid during her life and after deceas to be divided among my five forementioned children-----

I also make and ordain and constitute my brother John Robertson my whole and sole executor of this my Last Will and Testament disnuling all and every will or wills whatsoever as witness my hand an Seal this Thirtieth Day of August in the year of our Lork One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety One.
