I Hugh Gamble of Fairfield County and State of South Carolina, finding my self Weak of Body, but of perfect Sound Memory and Judgement, Thanks be to almighty God, and Calding to mind the uncertainty of this transitory Life, and that all Flesh must yield to Death when it pleases God to call, do make constitute and ordain and declare This to be my last Will and Testament, in Manner and Form revoking and Annulling by these presents all former Will or Wills by me made or declared, and this only to be taken as my last Will and Testaments and none other --- And first I leave my oul to God almighty and my Body to be decently buried Where and in That form my Executors Shall think proper- And for Setting my Affairs I do bid or give and dispose of the Same in Manner and Form following --VIZ,

First- I will that all my Just Debts be well and truly paid by my Executors -- Secondly I leave to my Wall beloved Wife --Agnes To Fairfield County Will Book and every of my -Estate to be Sold both real and personal, at public Vendue giving Six Months Credits -- Thirdly I leave and bequeath to my Beloved Wife Agnes one third of all the Moneys, arising from the Sale or that I die pofsesed of -- Forthly, I leave the other two thirds to my Daughter Nancy, excepting two Guineas to little Betsey off the whole head-- My Daughter Nancy to be schooled at the Discretion of my Executors. If my Daughter Nancy dies before She arises at the years of Maturity her chare of this Legacy then remaining to be divided, among my 'five Sisters in Ireland, Margaret, Mary, Sarah, Nancy -- Fifthly I leave two Guineas a peice to my five Sisters off the whole head, Sixthly my dear and loving Wife Agnes is to have the childs part in her hands -- And lastly I do hereby Ordain constitute and appoint my well beloved wife Agnes, John Bell Senior of Mill Creek, and Nathaniel Major my lawful Executors, to the end this my

last Will may be duly and fully executed
