Killoch as soon after they receive the same as possible hereby Impowering her to Sue for and recover the same for I also Give and bequeath to my said wife Margt. from them. Killoch all my wearing apparel money and goods which I have with me on board the said ship the Friendship. The Residue of my Effects after being turned into ready money I Give & bequeath after being divided into three equal parts in the following manner Vix. To my Child in case it lives to come of age one part and in case of its death to my wife Margt. Killoch. One part of the Same to my Brother James McMaster and to my dister Mary McMaster each one part or three equal shares of that part intended for my said Child my brother.

Give and bequeath to my Sister Mary McMaster.

My other Estate consisting of Fifty acres Situate and Lying in Ninety Six district Long Cane Settlement South Carolina I dive and Bequeath to my brother in Law the said James Killoch my Executor to him and his Heirs for ever of the First of the Money that is received by my Executor -I Give & Bequeath Twenty pounds to the Presbyterians or Covenanters that are settled in Ninety Six Empowering my said Executor Hugh McMullen to dispose of the Same as shall to him seem best for the Service of said Society I Give and Bequeath out of the next Sum or Sums-received by them Twenty pounds to be paid by said Executors to my wife Margt. Killoch as soon after they receive the same as possible her to Sue for and recover the same for hereby Impowering from them. I also Give and bequeath to my said wife Margt. Killoch all my ainstanding ouppar veil havney 7 2000-197000 which I have www.southcarolinapioneers.net with me on board the said ship the Friendship. The Residue of my Effects after being turned into ready money I Give & bequeath after being divided into three equal parts in the following manner Viz. To my Child in case it lives to come of age one part and in case of its death to my wife Margt. One part of the Same to my Brother James McMaster and to my Sister Mary McMaster each one part or three equal shares of that part intended for my said Child my brother. James McMaster and my Sister Mary Macmaster to have the other Two parts of the residue of my Effects. AND WHEREAS have in the hands of the said Arthur Morpow a Horse and Forty five yards of Linnen and in the Hands of Mary Boyd in Long Cane Settlement nineteen yards of Linnel which I left in mytheir Hands to be sold after my leaving America all which I Give and bequeath to the said James Killoch my Executor and
