

I James Andrews of the County of Fairfield of South Carolina Being Reasonable well in Body Mind & Memory Thanks be to God for his Mercies & Calling to mind the mortalety of my Body & that it is appointed for all men once to die; I therefore do make & ordain this My Last will & Testament in form & manner hereafter followeth utterly denying all other will or Instruments of writing made by me, & principally & first of all I difire To give my soul to God that give it & my Body when I die should be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned & Touching such worldly Effects as the Lord has Blefs me with I leave in form as followeth to wit ..... And first I difire that my loving wife Prifalah Andrews maybe mantanned out of my Estate should she be the Longest Liver -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Mathew Andrews the plantation or Tract of Land whareon I now live Containing Three hundred acres more or less formerly Granted to Ifaaed porcher & from Ifaae porther to Jofeph Karkland & from Jofeph Kerkeland to myself James Andrews -- with fifteen head of Cattle four head of horses fifty head of hogs three fethersbead with my house Hold & Kitchen furnature alfo my farming & planting utensels -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my daughter pateance Wallis one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Enoch Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son James Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Edward Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son John Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son David Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son William Andrews  
Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Awen Andrews one  
Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary McGraw one  
Shilling Sterling -----

And Lastly I appoint my Son Edward Andrews with my Son  
Mathew Andrews-- The Sole Executors of this my Last will  
& Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto Set my  
hand and Seal this 28. Day of October 1797 -----
