District and State of South Carolina being Verry Weak in Bod but of Perfect Mind and Memory thanks be Given unto God for the Same Calling to my Mind the Mortallity of My Body and Knowing that it is Appointed Once, for all men to Die do make and ordain this my Last Will & Testament. Principally and first of all I do Recommend My Soul into the Hands of Almighty God that Gave it and my Body to the Earth to be Bured in a Christian Manner Nothing Doubting But to Receive the Same again By the Mighty Power of god as Touching My Worldly Estate wherewith it hath Pleased God to Blefs me in this Life I do Demise and Dispose of the Same in the Following manner & form;

To Wit;

Impremis I do Give and Bequeath unto James Thompson my Eldest Son one Hundred & fifty Acres in Lawrence District adjoining lands of Samuel Bishop & Syepratex: Item the Other part of the tract of land whereon I lived to William Thompson my youngest son: Item I do Give and Bequeath unt Elizabeth My Daughter the Sum of Fifteen pounds to be leveyed out of the Estate-- Item I do Give and Bequeath unto Alexander Thompson My Son the Bay Mares Colt Valued to Sixty Dollars also Alexander Thompson is not to pay any Debts or Demands against the Estate, Also James Thompson is to pay to the Estate Sixty Dollars for His part of the Land Itim I do Give and Bequeath unto John Thompson my Grandeen five pounds Ster. Item the rest of the Estate after all my Just Debts is paid to be Equally Divided
