I John Young of Camden district in the State of South Carolina being very weak and Sickly of Body but of perfect Mind Memory and understanding and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make Constitute ordain and appoint this to be my last Will and Testament First and principally I recommend my Soul to the almighty God that Gave it and my Body to the Earth to be buried on a decent and Christianlike manner and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to blefs me in this Life I divide and dispose of it to my Family in manner and Form following. that is to say, I Give to my Son John Young the plantation I now live on over and above the rest I Give unto my dearly beloved wife Mary an equal propotion with my Children if she remains in her widowhood I Give to my daughter Agnes to my daughter Jane and to my daughter Sarah and to my wife Mary and Son ^{Fairfield County Will Bk 1, 1787-1791} ~~John~~ ^{an equal share} ~~my~~ ^{www.southcarolinapioneers.net} my Estate except my plantation I Give to my ^{SON} and daughter Moses Cockler and Jennet Cockler one Shilling Sterling each. I Give to my Son John Boyd my daughter Jennets Son one Ster aged one year and a half old Now I do make Constitute ordain and appoint my dearly beloved wife Mary, and my Brother Hugh Young to be my Lawful and true Executors of this my last will and Testament which I have Signed Sealed published pronounced and declared to be my last will and Testament and witnefs my hand this Tenth day of September one thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Six 1786.
