and mind do make and ordain this my last will and testament
in manner and form following. That is to say. First, I will
that all my debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged
by my Executrix hereafter named- Also I give and bequeath
unto my Wife Elizabeth Fellows all my lands and movable
Estate during her life and after her decease I will that her
son Moses Arledge shall be in full possession of all my real
and personal Estate to him and his heirs forever excepting
such things hereafter mentioned namely I will that Isaac
the 3d.
Arledge and Lydia Millar and Moses Arledge have all my horse
creatures equally divided amongst them Also I will that Hugh
Maner and Patience Ivey have each of them one good Cow and
calf lastly I do make and constitute my said wife Executrix
of this my last will and testament dated this twenty sixth
day of July in the year of our lord 1789

NB I give and bequeath demise unto the above mentioned Moses
Arledge all my lands together with two negroes namely one
Fellow named Paris and one young wench named Easter by him
to be possessed as above said after my said wives decease
to him and his heirs forever
